

## DECLARATION OF COVID 19 VACCINATION OR MOLECULAR TEST RESULTS

Travellers aged 12 years (+4 months) or older departing specified aerodromes in Canada are prohibited from boarding unless they are fully vaccinated, have received a result for a COVID-19 molecular test, or are boarding the aircraft for a flight to an aerodrome in Canada if that aircraft's initial scheduled departure time is no more than 24 hours after the departure time of a flight taken by the person to Canada from any other country. Travellers less than 16 years of age travelling alone are exempt.

Travelers must have the appropriate documents to prove this eligibility prior to entering the secure area of the airport and/or boarding a flight. Prior to presenting yourself to the check-in counter please indicate the following that applies to you:

### **SECTION 2**

#### Privacy and Information Sharing

The personal information in this form may be provided to Transport Canada for the purpose of audit and enforcement. The Minister of Transport may collect this personal information pursuant to the *Aeronautics Act*. #### COVID-19 molecular test result

##### The test result could be either negative or positive:

If the **test result is negative**, it must be dated within 72 hours of the travelers scheduled departure time in / from Canada. In the case of international arrivals and onward domestic flights, the pre-departure test conducted prior to arrival in Canada would remain valid until final destination;

OR

If the **test result is positive**, it must be dated at least 14 days before but not more than 180 days prior to the travelers scheduled departure time (e.g., the traveler would be eligible to travel on day 15 after their test was administered, since 14 days have passed). This accounts for those that had contracted COVID-19, have recovered, but may still be testing positive due to lingering amounts of the virus in their system.

International traveller authorized to enter Canada under an order made under section 58 of the *Quarantine Act* and who boards an aircraft for a flight in Canada within 24 hours of the time of departure of their inbound flight to Canada;

#### **IMPORTANT NOTICE:**

A person who provides information to an air carrier that is known to be false or misleading may be subject to an administrative monetary penalty or other enforcement action, including prosecution under the *Criminal Code*.

During travel, each traveller must carry with them the necessary proof to demonstrate, upon request, compliance.
